WELCOME



Preston Park cycle track was opened in 1887 making it the oldest in the country and the second oldest in the world.

During the 1950s, crowds of up to 10,000 would watch legends such as Reg Harris take on the Velodrome.

NOTES

Location: Preston Park is easily accessible being directly on the A23 which runs alongside the park. The velodrome is located from Preston Drove by car or through the park by bike or foot. The post code is BN1 6LA.

Parking: There is plenty of metered parking in the main car park off Preston Drove, at the south end of the park near the Rotunda Café, along Preston Park Avenue and along Preston Drove. Parking is free (but limited spaces) on the residential roads North of Preston Drove i.e. Bavant Road, Harrington Road etc. There is parking directly next to the track for Disabled Badge holders only.

Sign on and gear check: Are at the pavilion. Please have your bike gear checked before signing on. Signing on and gear checks from 8.45 to 9.45. Also there will be gear checks for selected riders after the TT and at other selected points in the programme.

Numbers: One on left hip tilted for iPad camera on finish line, and one lower middle back.



Light refreshments and cakes will be served in the pavilion.

Toilets and changing rooms are at the foot of the stairs in the pavilion.

Time Trial stations are numbers 1 at the start line and then continue anti-clockwise around the track.

You are expected to be ready in the rider's corral for the start of your race, do not assume you will be waited for. Listen for announcements and watch how the racing is progressing.

Riders and spectators are reminded that fair play and good manners are also part of racing and this should be evident in their conduct.

Crossing the track is only allowed between races and under the control of the gatekeeper.

Spare bikes are not permitted, riders must have only one track bike at the event. Riders must not have separate bikes for the Time Trials.

NOTES

For safety reasons, we have been informed by the visiting British Cycling officials that riders are expected to race on the drops at all times during bunch races. Riding on the hoods – including on integrated hood-style rests – is not permitted and may result in removal from the race. This approach is being applied at several other events in the National Youth Omnium series.

Any queries about competition regulations on the day should be directed towards the commissaire team, not club volunteers.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in helping ensure a safe racing environment for all riders.

Youth D and C Tri-bars, arm extensions and/or arm pads shall be prohibited. Wheels shall have a maximum rim depth of 35mm, have minimum of 16 and a maximum of 40 spokes. Spokes can be round, flattened or oval but must not exceed 10mm in width.			
Youth B Tri-bars, arm extensions and/or arm pads shall be prohibited. Wheels shall have a maximum rim depth of 40mm, have minimum of 16 and a maximum of 40 spokes. Spokes can be round, flattened or oval but must not exceed 10mm in width.			
Youth A Youth A riders can use deep section and disc wheels. During the time trial, Youth A riders may use tri-bars and arm extensions which comply with BC technical regulations.
